

Policy 5170 GYMNASTICS (Girls)

Approved Changes 5/11/11

I. Scheduling

All teams will compete in a single round-robin schedule and a division tournament at the end of the season.

Home sites for regular season matches will rotate each year.

Schedule will rotate every two years with the last game being moved to first and other games moved back accordingly.

Sub-varsity matches will take place at the same site and on the same day as varsity matches.

II. Division Championship Determination

Regular season will count one-half toward determining the champion.

Wins will be worth two points in the standings, a tie one point, and a loss zero points.

The division tournament will count one-half toward determining the champion.

Regular season champion will receive the same number of points as there are teams in the division. Points will be awarded to other teams in descending order of finish.

Tournament champion will receive the same number of points as there are teams in the division. Points will be awarded to other teams in descending order of finish.

Regular season points will be added to tournament points and the team with the highest point total will be declared the champion.

If two or more teams earn the same final number of points they will all be named champion.

III. Starting Times

Varsity at 6:30 p.m.

IV. Rules of the Game

All matches will be conducted under the rules of the MHSAA and the NFHS.

V. Host School Responsibilities

Provide at least two registered MHSAA officials.

Equipment necessary to run the meet.

Water and ice for both teams.

Locker room available one-hour prior to the scheduled start.

Certified athletic trainer or doctor (if possible).

Visiting teams are expected to provide its own athletic training tape.

VII. Pre-Game and Warm-Up

Equipment is to be available sixty-minutes prior to the start of the match.
Varsity teams get a minimum of sixty-minutes for warm-up.
Any adjustment to the warm-up time must be mutually agreed upon by both schools.
